North Olmsted, Ohio . . . MoenStone® sinks have long been the standard for both beauty and durability in the kitchen. Now they set the stage for versatility as well.

Moen has expanded its MoenStone sink line by including a new double bowl kitchen sink and matching preparatory and bar sinks so that both gourmet chefs and kitchen designers can enjoy coordinated kitchen looks with practical design elements.

A particular highlight is Moen's new big/medium double bowl sink. This provides for additional work space with a deeper, more spacious sink while still being built around standard 33" X 22" dimensions.

Also new to the line are secondary MoenStone sinks including the increasingly popular prep sink, which is slightly smaller at 22" X 18", and a new matching bar/entertainment sink, which is 15" X 15". The latter now carries the "suite" look across kitchen islands, bars, dens and great rooms where another sink is always a welcome addition.

These new sinks are available in the full palette of complementary MoenStone colors, or consumers can mix and match depending on their countertop surface and kitchen décor. Moen offers seven colors of sinks including glacier, sand, black, graphite, ivory, and recently introduced sapphire and yellow stone.

Beside their great looks, MoenStone sinks feature high-tech, high-strength composite materials that stand up to everyday cuts, scuffs and dents. This durable combination of natural quartz stone and acrylic polymer provides fade-proof brilliance that also resists stains.

Unlike kitchen sinks made with less resistant components, such as polyester-based materials, MoenStone's tough, hard surface is especially manufactured to withstand kitchen tasks. The sink's chemical composition resists damage from harsh cleaning materials or liquids that may stain, can withstand temperatures up to 446° F from hot pots and pans, and fights thermal conductivity to keep dishwasher warm.

MoenStone's composite material won't rust, dent or flake because it is a uniform material which is colored throughout – and features the high-gloss appearance preferred by consumers who seek the look of traditional cast iron sink finishes.

With many different shapes and sizes offered, these sinks can accommodate as many as seven holes (double bowl models) on the top to accommodate extras like sprayers and dispensers for liquid soaps and/or lotions.

All models feature installation in an over- or under-mount configuration. Either way, it is accomplished quickly and easily thanks to a simple patented clamping feature designed to ensure a tight, long-lasting seal to the countertop for years of dependable, leak-proof service.
